Through our collaboration, we will work to explore your concerns and to uncover creative ways to make changes in your life while acknowledging sources of strength and resiliency. My clinical interests include trauma, anxiety, grief, and relationship issues. I enjoy developing unconventional strategies with clients and often include art as a tool in counseling.
